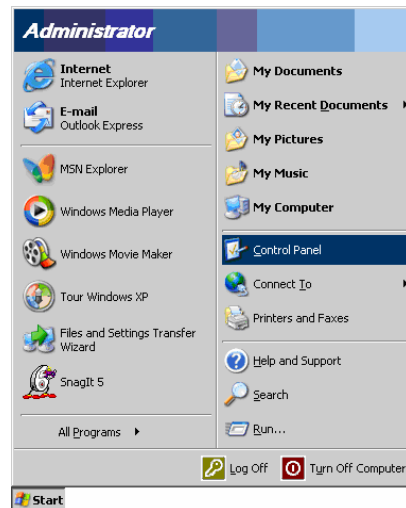
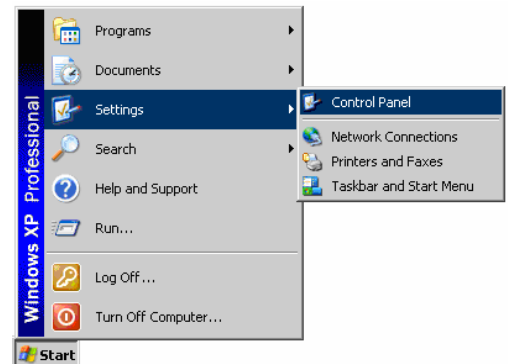


1. Click on the Start menu, select Control Panel

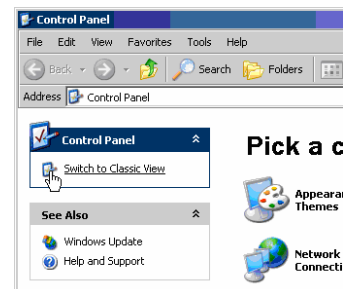


Note: If you are running Windows XP in classic mode, you will need to:

a. *Select the Start menu, select Settings, then choose Control Panel.*



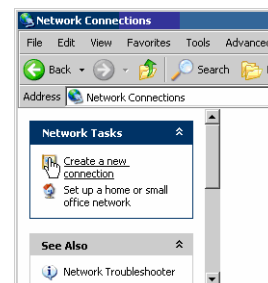
b. Then in Control Panel, click the Switch to Classic View icon



2. Double-click the Network Connections icon



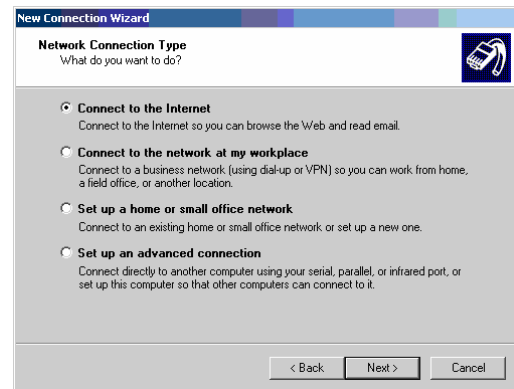
3. Click the Create a new connection icon



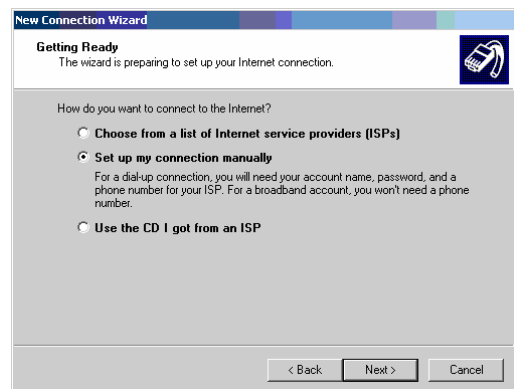
4. The *Welcome to the New Connection Wizard* screen will open. Click the **Next** button.



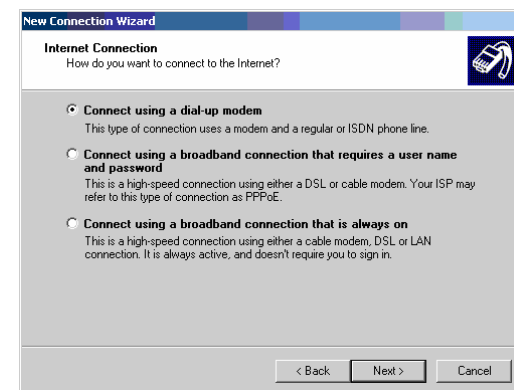
5. Select **Connect to the Internet**. Click the **Next** button.



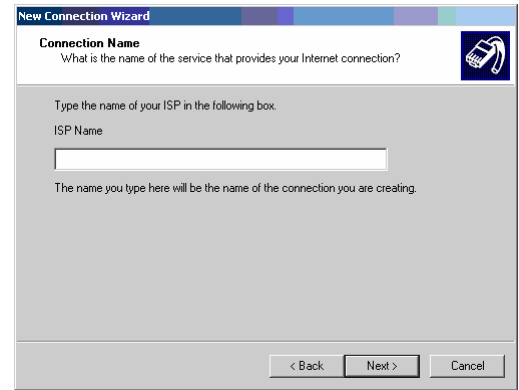
6. Select **Set up my connection manually**. Click the **Next** button



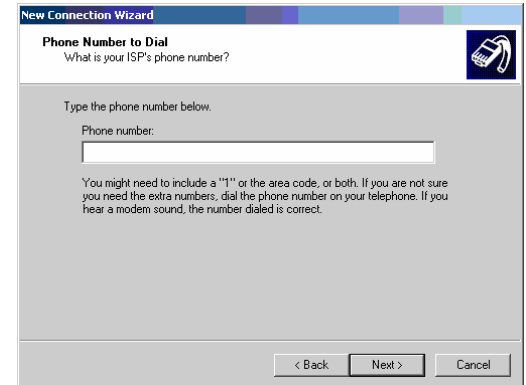
7. Select **Connect using a dial-up modem** and Click the **Next** button.



8. In the **ISP Name** field, enter **Caribe.Net** to identify your connection. Click the **Next** button.

In the **Password:** field, type your **Password**.

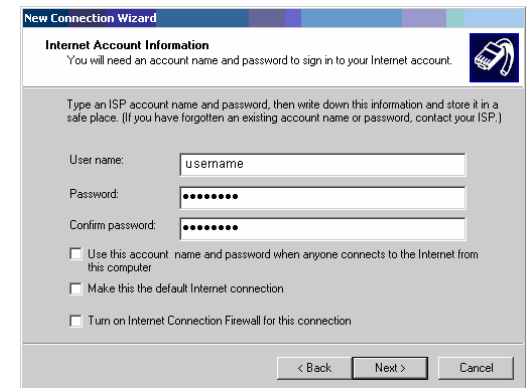
In the **Confirm password:** field, type your **Password**.
